The **Wisconsin Breast Cancer Coalition** continues to “have the backs” of breast cancer survivors and breast cancer organizations in Wisconsin. We keep the community informed about policy and other matters that affect everyone.

In the past year, we pressed legislators to help strengthen the Wisconsin Well Woman Program and to add insurance coverage to a new breast density notification law. We brought our free educational programming on breast cancer prevention to Green Bay, Oshkosh and La Crosse. We were on the planning committee of a Metastatic Breast Cancer Symposium, actively supported the Sister Pact campaign to reduce breast cancer disparities in Milwaukee, and held a Speaker Forum on ethical challenges for breast cancer advocates. With partners like the National Breast Cancer Coalition, we helped protect funding for breast cancer research. In 2018 and beyond, we will be working to add metastatic breast cancer to the list of qualifying conditions for Medicare coverage.



Our annual gala raises most of the funds we need to do our work throughout the year. WBCC is entirely donor funded, and we need community partners like you to keep fighting our good fight.
